

Need strong transitive verbs? Here are 250 eminently suitable actions or tactics for verbalizing characters. Remember:

- The ACTION is something the character does every moment of a story. It
 expresses their essential nature, not something they want to do or used
 to do, but something they are always doing to achieve their story goal. A
 character's Action arises from their Void.
- TACTICS are synonyms of the action (and synonyms of synonyms), which
 reveal the character's re-action specific to a situation the story unfolds
 to achieve their scene goal. For character to cohere, tactics must cohere.
 Tactics express a character's Grace.
